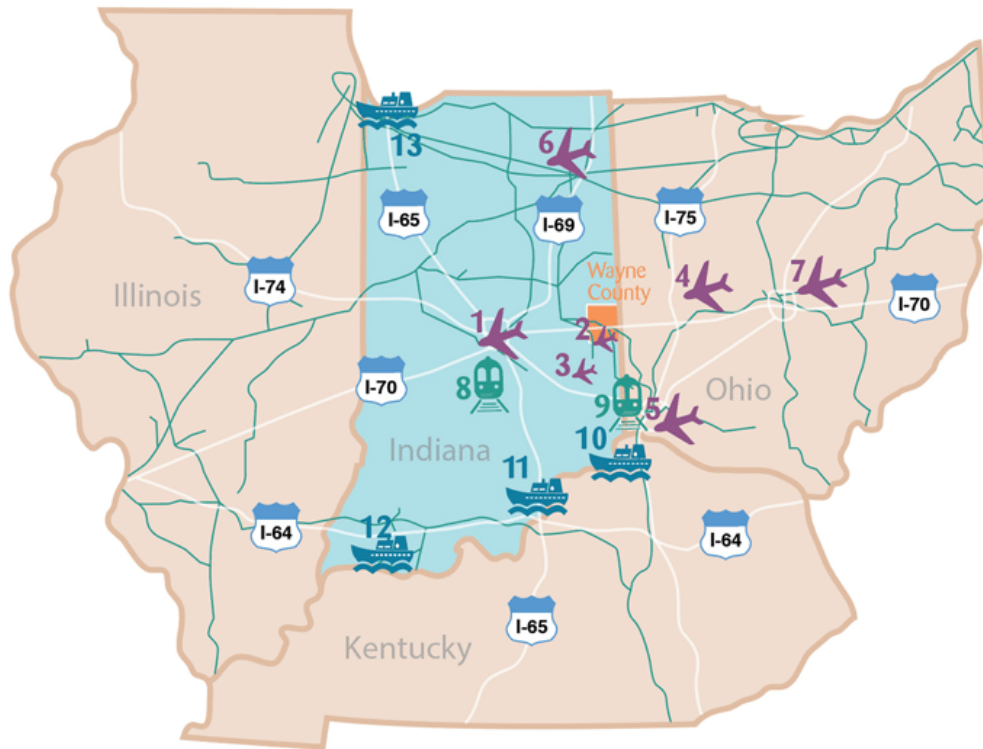

Our location in East Central Indiana provides a number of alternatives for your company's distribution and transportation needs. In Wayne County you'll find direct access to **Interstate 70 and several state and federal highways.**

You'll find access to **Class I rail as well as short lines and intermodal facilities.** The Senate Avenue Intermodal in Indianapolis avoids crowded Chicago rail yards and provides access to Asian markets within 21 days. You'll find several options for **over-the-road trucking** as well as access to three major **international airports and several regional airports.**

Need a way to ship your product by water? Even in Indiana we have access to several **water ports providing access to two major freight transportation arteries: the Great Lakes/St. Lawrence Seaway (via Lake Michigan) and the Inland Waterway System (via the Ohio River).**
